

# October Meeting Report

Kyle Jardine

Kyle Jardine, our guest for October, is known for his vibrant personality, distinctive paint-stained clothing, and strikingly colourful artworks. His creative journey began in theatre, where designing sets and costumes has had a lasting influence on his painting style. Kyle demonstrates that it is possible to lead a creative and opulent lifestyle.

In his art, Kyle creates texture using paste and styrofoam, which he attaches to his canvases with cold glue. He embraces the philosophy that 'more is more,' preferring acrylic paint for its quick drying time and finishing his pieces with a highly glossy varnish. Although he does not consider himself a figure painter, figures in his work are often incomplete, lacking facial features. Kyle draws inspiration from his surroundings; for example, his "Bouquet of Bananas" was inspired by a display of fruit cascading from a vase. His paintings frequently feature words such as "love" or "darling," which hold personal meaning for him. He often signs the back of his paintings or cleverly incorporates his signature into a mystical object within the artwork.



Kyle typically focuses on large-scale pieces, but he brought two smaller examples to share with us. He exhibits his work in both local and international galleries. We are all invited to visit Kyle's open studio on 29th November, where he and his colleagues will be sharing their skills with the public at Side Str Studio, 48 Albert Road, Woodstock. 




